What do you think about Hmong American kids?

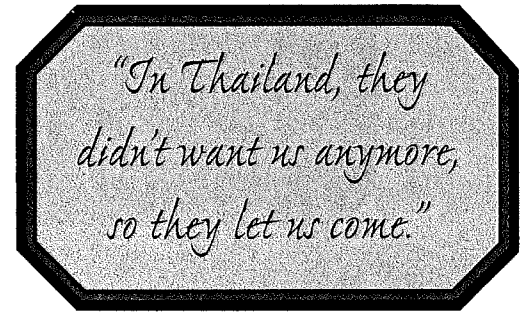
They are good.
